- EVENT:** 5km **CLASSICAL** 15 second interval start
- SEEDING:** Coaches to seed skiers as they deem.
AWARDS: Awards will be at approximately 3:15 pm in the Stadium. Racers must be present to win the bib draws.
- COACHES MEETING:** 9:15 am in the first floor of the timing building (optional).
- WAX TESTING:** Wax testing allowed on the course up to 15 minutes before the start. Everyone must ski in the direction of the race course.
- WAXING:** Wax rooms available (for a fee) in the wax building on a first come first serve basis. Email chisholmski@gmail.com to reserve a room.
- COURSE MOVEMENT:** Spectators and coaches are welcome out on the side of the course during race. Coaches must be wearing a coach's bib. All others will require a nordic pass. Skiers must travel in the direction of the race course at all times.
- REGISTRATION:** Entry fee **\$11.00 per athlete**. Two coaches comp passes per team.
